These vacancies are to be filled under an affirmative measure to improve employment opportunities for Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people in the Australian Public Service. They are open only to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people.

The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) is forming an Indigenous Coordination Team (the team) to provide leadership and coordination of Agency business supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities and people with disability throughout Australia.

The team sits within the Scheme Practice Approaches (SPA) Branch, which is responsible for implementing approaches to deliver the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) which are flexible and inclusive of diverse population groups.

The purpose of these positions are to drive and deliver key projects within the team as well as the broader objectives of SPA branch and Agency. This will contribute to the design, development and implementation of approaches which support inclusion, equity, flexibility and innovation in the delivery and experience of the NDIS.
