The Senior Policy Advisor is primarily responsible for leading the development and review of policies, programs and procedures and leading the development and implementation of the ILC's monitoring and evaluation framework and activities.

Reporting to the Manager Policy and Program Development, the successful applicant will also be required to:

- prepare high-quality oral and written advice, briefings and other correspondence on policy, strategic planning, program development and evaluation issues, to the ILC Board, Senior Management, employees and external stakeholders
- undertake research and information collation, including facilitating consultation with staff and stakeholders
- liaise with internal and external stakeholders through representing the ILC at meetings, preparation of submissions and other correspondence
