ACON is seeking an enthusiastic and creative person to coordinate and support our work with the Aboriginal LGBTI community, with a particular focus on gay Aboriginal men. ACON's Aboriginal programs aim to build the health and wellbeing of LGBTI, and HIV-affected, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples through a culturally appropriate model focused on peer education, community development and outreach at major community events.

The Role

The position coordinates delivery of ACON's HIV and sexual health promotion within the LGBTI Aboriginal community, especially gay Aboriginal men, ensuring that ACON responds appropriately to the community's identified needs. The role will also work and liaise with other health and community services and events to enhance the understanding and capacity to effectively meet the needs of Aboriginal lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex individuals.

You will have a demonstrated understanding of community development and health promotion principles and knowledge of LGBTI and Aboriginal communities. Capacity to design, implement and evaluate health promotion activities, as well as effective communication skills, is essential.
