As an EL2, you will contribute to strategic planning and policy development and service delivery across all the department’s responsibilities, which include foreign policy; development; trade and investment; corporate management; and consular and passport services.

Applicants must be Australian citizens to be eligible for engagement. Successful applicants will undergo a comprehensive security assessment. Employment in the department is dependent on gaining a valid security clearance. Loss of a security clearance at any time will lead to termination of employment. These are security designated positions and successful applicants will be required to have or be able to obtain a security clearance to Negative Vetting Level 2.
