To be eligible to apply, you will:

- Be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident and
- Identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person and be accepted as such within your community
- Be available for commencement of the internship in January 2018
- Be able to work at ABC Ultimo Centre in Sydney, close to Central Station. Please note there will be no reimbursement of relocation costs if the successful applicant resides outside of Sydney.

What skills do I need to work at the ABC?

You'll learn most of the skills you need on the job combined with your formal tertiary training however you will already be equipped with:

- A passion for digital design
- Well-developed communication skills, both written and verbal
- A proven ability to problem solve and self-manage workload
- Good organisational and time management skills
