Wirringa Baiya is a NSW statewide, gender specific community legal centre. The Centre is an Aboriginal specialist service, which works primarily with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women, children and youth.

Wirringa Baiya is seeking to employ a Family Violence Support Worker. This person must have case management skills. They must have an understanding of issues, which affect the Aboriginal community, specifically in relation to the impact of domestic and family violence upon women and children.

The rate of pay is based on Level 4 Pay Point 2, as per the SCHADS award. Hourly rate \$36.27. Salary packaging is available. The Centre is located in Marrickville.

Applicants must address all of the selection criteria contained in the job pack. The applicant must have a drivers licence.
