AHL is seeking to engage highly motivated individuals to join our hostel team in Sydney. Both full-time and part-time positions are available for immediate filling, and we are also seeking to create a merit list for filling future vacancies and to establish a pool of on-call casual employees who are available to work at short notice.

As a Hostel Worker, you will have primary responsibility for undertaking the duties of one of the following roles, whilst having flexibility to perform other duties when required:

- Hostel Worker – Cook
- Hostel Worker – Kitchenhand
- Hostel Worker – Housekeeper
- Hostel Worker – Night Attendant

You will work under the general direction of the Duty Manager and will be responsible for working in collaboration with other hostel workers on a daily basis, ensuring a high standard of service is delivered to our residents.

- are committed to working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- have a strong focus on customer service, with the ability to communicate effectively, and work in a team environment
- are in good physical health and can walk, lift and carry, and who can work to a flexible schedule
- can prepare meals in an industry based environment and prepare quality food without compromise to Food Safety Standards Australia (Cooks)
- can complete housekeeping and cleaning tasks in a productive and efficient manner (Housekeepers)
- can perform cleaning duties within the kitchen in a productive and efficient manner (Kitchenhands)
- can perform security duties and insure the safety of the hostel is to its best standard (Night Attendant)
