Who can apply?

To be eligible to apply you will:

- Be an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident and
- Identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person and be accepted as such within your community
- Be available for commencement of the internship in January 2018
- Be able to work at ABC Ultimo Centre in Sydney, close to Central Station. Please note there will be no reimbursement of relocation costs if the successful applicant resides outside of Sydney

What skills do I need?

- You'll learn most of the skills you need on the job combined with your formal tertiary training however, you will already be equipped with:
- Creative flare coupled with a good initiative
- Well-developed analytical skills and the confidence to ask questions
- An ability to follow direction and work in a collaborative team environment
- Good organisational and time management skills
- Well-developed communication skills, both written and verbal
