You will have the capacity to work well individually and as part of a team and have the ability to deal with conflict in a professional manner. You will have some experience conducting investigations and/or audits.

You will be appointed as an Inspector under the BCIP Act and must hold a current driver's license.

- Demonstrated ability to work independently and as a member of a team
