ACON is a New South Wales based health promotion organisation specialising in HIV prevention, HIV support and lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex (LGBTI) health. Over the past 12 months, ACON has drafted a Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP), which is awaiting approval by Reconciliation Australia.

ACON invites Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander artists currently living in NSW to enter their work for consideration for our first Reconciliation Action Plan, which will be published in print and online. ACON will select one artist's work, which will be used on the cover of and throughout the document. Works by artists with LGBTIQ identity or experience and/or who are HIV positive will be given priority.

### **ACON will award a prize of \$2000 to the selected artist.**

- Visual artworks in any medium are eligible (digital, mixed-media, photographic, paint, sculptural)
- 3 dimensional / sculptural work is welcome if the artist is happy for it to appear as 2 dimensional photographic imagery
- Artists are welcome to make multiple submissions if they would like us to consider more than one of their work

Artists must agree to the **Terms and Conditions** of the competition before submitting their entry.
