The Programme Officer, Indigenous Apprenticeship Programme works under limited direction from the Assistant Director/s to develop/implement recruitment strategies and programs to support the Indigenous Apprenticeships Programme.

A key requirement of the role involves extensive project management, which includes coordinating multiple program activities including but not limited to; sourcing, selecting, onboarding, program participation, and event management.

There is a requirement to build and maintain professional and cultural relationships with program participants, their managers as well as industry and public sector organisations. A high degree of professional tact, sensitivity and cultural awareness is needed to manage HR issues arising from employee participation.
