



Child Family Contact Support Worker

The Child Family Contact Support Worker will support families growth and development in parenting, relationship building with their children with the aim of reunifying children with their parents or extended family members. This role will also involve supporting children to remain connected to their family, community and culture when reunification is not possible, by creating meaningful and quality contact experiences for families

Family Support Worker

The Family Support Worker will work together with whole families to keep children safely in the home. You will help children keep connected to family, culture and community while helping parents and caregivers strengthen their skills to provide healthy relationships, learning opportunities and supportive environments for children to grow up in.

This role will use case management to support families to achieve their desired goals and those identified by Child Protection, to strengthen their access to specialised services and expand their social and community connectedness.
