In addition, the Lecturer B – Resources and Infrastructure will assist the Senior Lecturer – Resources and Infrastructure with particular duties:

- Teaching, management and facilitation of culturally appropriate training and learning activities;
- Student assessments, maintenance of student records, supervision of students, and monitoring student progression;

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- Student assessments, maintenance of student records, supervision of students, and monitoring student progression;
- Liaison with students, community and industry partners;
- Participate in activities and all requirements of the Division of Further Education
- Development of appropriate teaching resources and assessment materials.

The successful candidate must possess a relevant vocational qualification (see third bullet point below), combined with a minimum of 5 years Industry/professional/vocational experience.

The successful applicant will hold

- The minimum vocational teaching qualification Certificate IV in Training and Assessment TAE40110 (or equivalent) and/or Diploma or higher level qualification in adult education
- The Working with Children Clearance (Ochre Card).
- Engineering Trade Certificate with capacity to teach High Risk licenses, Cert III in Civil Construction (Plant Operations) and Certificate I and II in Automotive Vocational Preparation
- NT White Card
