Working as a critical part of the team, you will be able to lead by example and drive outcomes.

For this role you will need to have excellent communication skills and a proven track record of operating across multiple projects at a Senior Project Officer level to achieve desired outputs.

Senior Project Officer, Knowledge Management (one position)

The Senior Project Officer, Research and Clinical Trials will assist with the administration of Cancer Australia's Support for Cancer Clinical Trials program and will support the Agency's national grants program – the Priority-driven Collaborative Cancer Research Scheme (PdCCRS).

Through the Support for Cancer Clinical Trials program Cancer Australia funds 14 national Cooperative Cancer Clinical Trials Groups and a range of national technical services which support the work of these groups. The PdCCRS is an annual collaborative grants funding scheme which funds cancer research in areas of identified priority.
