The curator will also work closely with the Dja Dja Wurrung people on the protection and presentation of cultural objects. The ideal candidate will have sound knowledge of Aboriginal cultural heritage management relevant to south-eastern Australia including current legislation and demonstrated experience developing cultural programs and exhibitions.
