Boorndawan Willam Aboriginal Healing Service provides culturally safe services that assist Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, women, men and families in their healing journey to address the impacts of family violence. BWAHS is currently in the process of transiting to an independent organisation from EACH which has held oversight responsibility for the service since 2006.

About The Role

The Boorndawan Willam Aboriginal Healing Service (BWAHS) is seeking a person who has a good understanding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and society, who is qualified and/or has experience working in the family violence field, to work as part of a diverse team of professionals to deliver quality care to the community in the Eastern Metropolitan Region. The Integrated Family Services (IFS) Worker provides early intervention case management support to vulnerable Aboriginal children, young people and their families.

About the Position

Using a strengths-based approach, the IFS Worker will undertake comprehensive needs and risk assessments of children, young people and their families, develop child and family action plans that promote Aboriginal children's safety, stability and healthy development. A key focus of the role is to work in collaboration with other BWAHS programs and in partnership with other family services to ensure a comprehensive integrated service delivery.
