Boorndawan Willam Aboriginal Healing Service provides culturally safe services that assist Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, women, men and families in their healing journey to address the impacts of family violence. BWAHS is currently in the process of transiting to an independent organisation from EACH which has held oversight responsibility for the service since 2006.

About the Position

This position is being funded to trial a case management program for men who use violence and is an initiative of the Victorian State Government and addresses a recommendation of the Victorian Royal Commission into Family Violence to provide individual case management to Aboriginal men with complex needs. Using a strengths-based approach, the case manager will provide individual case management to men with complex needs who use violence. Working in collaboration with other service providers to ensure a comprehensive integrated service delivery, you will be responsible for ensuring that the goals identified in the case plan are met. The successful candidate will have demonstrated case management skills and experience working in the family violence sector. You will have a clear understanding of the dynamics of family violence in the context of contemporary Aboriginal culture and the history of intergenerational trauma.

To be successful in this role you will have relevant tertiary qualification in Social Work, Psychology or a related social science discipline.

- Committed to case management that aims to reduce the risks associated with men who use family violence by providing individual responses that address the barriers to change?
- Able to develop and maintain strong and effective working relationships with a wide range of relevant agencies, services and sectors?
