The Court has a demonstrated commitment to meeting the needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, in relation to the Court's core business of resolving or determining family disputes.

The focus of the position is to liaise between the Court and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people faced with family breakdown that could result or has resulted in interaction between an Indigenous family and the various services provided by the Court.

People at this level are responsible for providing support to individuals and families requiring access to the services of the Court, as well as representing the Court to the community. They are also responsible for explaining the needs of Indigenous people to the various parts of the Court and other service providers.

They are required to develop and maintain collaborative partnerships with local colleagues inside the Court as well as establish and maintain external networks.

The person appointed to this position is expected to carry out his or her duties so as to:

- satisfy all relevant statutory obligations
- satisfy the Australian Public Service Values and Code of Conduct
- contribute to and support achievement of the Court's Strategic and Business Plans
- operate within the Court's policies and procedural guidelines, and
- support and contribute to the Court's Service Charter.
