This is a permanent full time contract ideally based in Sydney. However, we are open to flexible arrangements for the right candidate.

hitting copy, and coming up with creative ways to give our members the best chance for impact.

- Achieving team fundraising targets, and managing team expenditure;
- Representing GetUp in the community and media;
- Leading on engagement strategies with key stakeholders, including political offices;
- Ensuring a strong team culture of experimentation, innovation and evaluation;
- Managing campaigns teams to success, including setting and monitoring work outcomes.

You will be someone who has/is:

- a deeply held commitment to social justice, who is passionate about creating progressive change, specifically environmental and climate justice;
- adept at thinking through complex politics and communicating simply and clearly, and who thrives in a fast-paced office environment;
- capable of working autonomously on a range of varied tasks and projects, and takes the initiative to do whatever it takes to get the job done;
- a formidable manager who knows how to take care of their staff and can coordinate a team to success, celebrate and evaluate; and
- passionate about growing and strengthening a movement of everyday people committed to tackling the climate crisis
- at least five years of relevant professional experience.

Bonus points for:

- Experience working in the media cycle and
- Policy training or experience
