The appointee will be placed within a School/Institute in the Health Group depending on their experience and field of study. They will contribute to research and scholarship in their field and to the development of the profession.

To perform this role, it is essential that the person who holds the position be an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person. It is therefore a genuine occupational requirement, under section 25 of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1991, that applicants are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people.

This is a three-year fixed-term position, based at the Gold Coast campus. While this position is advertised as full time, a fractional appointment with flexible working can be negotiated.
