General Manager – Myimbarr & Housing

We are seeking an experienced Manager to lead the Myimbarr & Housing operations ensuring the delivery of a comprehensive “one stop shop” service offering in our community that is client centric, high quality and culturally appropriate. This is a full time 12-month fixed term position, with possibility for extension.

Myimbarr is the IAC Out of Home Care program which aims to keep Aboriginal children & young people in safe environments, to promote their education and emotional wellbeing and remain connected with their family and community. When children or young people cannot live with their family, we work towards restoring them with their natural (birth) family. When this is not possible, we support children & young people in culturally aware, trained and loving Aboriginal foster families.

The IAC also offers Social Housing for Aboriginal people in the Illawarra and surrounding regions. Clients with higher level or more complex needs are supported through the Going Home Staying Home (GHSH) and Koori Strong programs. The Housing program works to reduce the impact of homelessness by providing affordable housing. As an Aboriginal community housing provider the program offers social housing with a direct cultural connection. We aim to provide fair, transparent and culturally appropriate housing services for the local Aboriginal community.

To be successful in this position you will need;

- Significant experience in a management position delivering exceptional Out of Home Care, Social Housing and related support services to families, children and carers
- Demonstrated mentoring skills and experience leading and developing a high performing team within the Out of Home Care and/or Social Housing sector
- Proven ability to build and maintain partnerships with multiple stakeholders including community groups, agencies and government departments as well as engaging with the local Aboriginal Community
- In depth working knowledge of Child Protection and Social Housing Legislation and current changes in these sectors
- Proven experience working to strict compliance and accreditation standards
- Detailed understanding of trauma informed practise
- Demonstrated ability to manage complex issues and perform under pressure
- Exceptional consultation and interpersonal skills
- Tertiary Qualifications in Social Work, Psychology, Community Services or related field.
