You will provide individualised support to young people through role modelling, facilitating personal development and encouraging mentees to participate in their community. This is a casual position offering 6 hours per fortnight per mentee.

- Possess the ability to build a positive and non-judgemental relationship with clients, showing respect for the client's feelings and needs.
- Excellent communication skills both written and verbal.
