Jabiru Community College (JCC) is based in Bracken Ridge, North Brisbane. We are a young, small community that provides education for 75 young people seeking a flexible, caring and holistic approach to learning. 20% of our current students identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

#### **The Purpose of this position is to:**

- To build and maintain strong connections across the school community using community development principles through the hub of a kitchen.
- To work as a member of a team and with our whole learning community to build a place that is safe and supportive for all members.
- To develop, coordinate and deliver food and wellbeing strategies that help young people feel nurtured and cared for and provide opportunities for them to participate in and contribute to a nurturing community.
- Help link young people with services in the wider community that support their health and wellbeing.

We are looking for a **Youth and Community Development Worker: Food and Wellbeing** to come on the journey with us as we reimagine quality education for young people on the margins. Workers in our learning community aspire to the following:

- Contributing to reconciliation processes and working together with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities and non-Indigenous communities for the benefit of all of our community members;
- A willingness to listen to and acknowledge the diversity of experience of the young people and workers in the community, including those who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, those who come from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, those from marginalised or disadvantaged backgrounds and those who have a diversity of gender or sexual identities.
- Listening out for the hopes, dreams, capacities and skills of young people and the colleagues we work with;
- Working in a trans-disciplinary way - sharing with and learning from colleagues from other disciplines and backgrounds in a team setting;
- Taking care of ourselves and each other and holding on to hope and optimism;
- Being able to work hard to lovingly put our ideas into action.

#### **Applicants must have:**

- A current manual drivers licence
- Bachelor's Degree in a relevant discipline or extensive experience in Community Development with a passion for food and wellbeing.
- A current Blue Card or ability to apply for one
