- Meet all requirements and eligibility to apply for Nursing Registration with AHPRA
- Provide all required documentation as requested
- Provide documentation supporting Australian Residency status (i.e. proof of residency or citizenship - if applicable)
- Overseas students must have documented proof of English Language skills to an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic Band 7 / or OET with score of B, or evidence of a booking for a test at the time of interview
- VISA (if applicable)
- Be able to undertake 11 months part time employment
- Display effective interpersonal skills and be able to build rapport with a diverse range of people
- Be able to accept professional accountability for own actions/practice
- Be aware of own limitations and scope of practice
- Have a strong ability to work closely with multidisciplinary teams and provide exceptional "Person Centred Care"
- Demonstrate commitment to ongoing professional development
