As a result, services provision needs to be flexible and responsive to the diverse needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people.

The Indigenous Youth Cultural Inclusion Officer is responsible for engagement and delivery of programs and youth support services for local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander youth within the designated Mornington Peninsula catchment areas. These programs will have a self-determination focus and centre on self and cultural identity, connection to community and educational and employment pathways.
