The Kulbardi Aboriginal Centre is responsible for the support of Murdoch University's Indigenous students. The Centre provides access programs for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to undertake university studies. It is also responsible for the implementation of recruitment and retention strategies that seek to improve educational outcomes for Indigenous people and their communities.

### The Role

The primary responsibility of this role is to assist the University in the development and implementation of Murdoch University Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students and Education strategy.

The Equity Project Officer will work with the Director Aboriginal Education Equity and Inclusion and Manager Kulbardi Aboriginal Centre (KAC) in the development of an Aboriginal Employment Strategy, and will support Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) working parties in the analysis of current barriers impacting the Murdoch Aboriginal community.

### Skills and Experience

The preferred candidate will have a sound understanding of the difficulties Aboriginal groups within Australia face in relation to education, training and employment. They will also have demonstrated experience in project coordination, be an excellent communicator, and have the ability to create and foster effective relationships with internal and external stakeholders.
