



Call for expressions of interest Various locations across Queensland Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal

The Honourable Yvette D'Ath MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, seeks expressions of interest for the following:

- Full or part-time appointment as a permanent Ordinary Member of QCAT located in Brisbane;
- Appointment as a legally qualified Ordinary Member, on a sessional basis, of QCAT at various locations in Queensland;
- Full or part-time appointment as a permanent Adjudicator of QCAT located in Brisbane for work across South East Queensland; and
- Appointment as a legally qualified Justice of the Peace, on a sessional basis of QCAT, located at Brisbane, Ipswich, Maroochydore, Southport or Townsville.

Please note that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples who are legally qualified or hold any other relevant qualifications are encouraged to apply as members, sessional members, adjudicators and Justices of the Peace.

QCAT is an independent statutory body established under the *Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act*.

Ordinary Members hear and decide matters within the Tribunal as determined by the President.

Adjudicators are responsible for hearing minor civil disputes (including residential tenancy disputes) up to the value of \$25,000 and other less complex or non-contentious matters before the Tribunal.

QCAT Justices of the Peace are responsible for hearing minor civil disputes with a value of \$5,000 or less, excluding urgent tenancy disputes, in a panel made up of two qualified JPs, one of which must be legally qualified.
