### What you'll be doing

MH-Children and Young People is a unit of the Mental Health Branch, NSW Health that provides leadership and support for children's and young people's mental health programs and services and has a state-wide brief. MH-Children and Young People is based at Gladesville and hosted on a remote basis by the Sydney Children's Hospitals Network (SCHN) and MH-Children and Young people staff members are employees of SCHN. MH-Children and Young People aims to improve the mental health of NSW children, young people and those who care for them by working collaboratively with policy makers and service providers to support the best use of available evidence, the dissemination of relevant information and the development of meaningful partnerships for service and program development, innovation and quality and safety improvement.

Specifically, this position will:

- Assist in the development of effective mechanisms for enhancing interdepartmental and cross-agency service delivery to meet the needs of the Government's stated priorities with regard to services for Aboriginal children, young people and their families
- Develop appropriate agreements, protocols and models for interagency coordination and Partnerships relating to mental health problems and mental health services delivery for Aboriginal children, young people and their families
- Represent NSW Health Mental Health Branch in interagency forums on Aboriginal Health
- Provide expert advice on appropriate mechanisms for evaluation and quality improvement in mental health services, in particular strategies that address improving access for Aboriginal children, young people and their families
- Leads relevant MH-Children and Young People's initiatives for Aboriginal children, young people and their families aligned with the NSW 2021: A Plan to make NSW Number One, the Fifth National Mental Health and Suicide Prevention Plan, the NSW Strategic Framework and Workforce Plan for Mental Health 2018-2022, and the NSW Aboriginal Mental Health and Wellbeing Framework.
