- you'll then move forward with an integrated strategic approach and workplan for stakeholders broader than our immediate University community (which currently incorporates Camperdown, Westmead, Lidcombe, Lismore, Broken Hill and Camden).
- you will map relationships with key partners across government, industry, community, NGOs and others to enhance our reach and areas of practice.
