Please note this vacancy is only available to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander peoples.

Eligible applicants will be:

1. of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
2. identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander; and
3. accepted by their community as being Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

Applicants that are deemed suitable for interview will be required to provide one of the following documents:

1. a letter signed by the Chairperson of an incorporated Indigenous organisation confirming that the applicant is recognised as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person, or
2. a confirmation of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent document executed by an Indigenous organisation.

The successful applicant must be an Australian citizen and have, or be willing to undergo a security clearance to the level of Negative Vetting 2 as a condition of employment.
