Specific responsibilities for this role include:

#### LEVEL C:

- Develop and/or contribute to a program of high quality research that is consistent with the broad research aims of the CIBEL Centre;
- Contribute to the teaching excellence of the CIBEL Centre and the Law School through the development of courses and curricula, preparation and delivery of lectures and seminars, consultation with students, participation in CIBEL and Law Faculty administration and coordination of courses, assessment of students, and supervision of undergraduate and postgraduate research projects and theses;
- Attract research funding from the Australian Research Council and/or international sources;
- Contribute to the CIBEL Centre and the School's accomplishments in service within and beyond UNSW, and make a significant contribution to CIBEL and UNSW, the profession, and/or the discipline;
- Involvement in professional activities and other forms of external engagement;
- Broad administrative functions
- Participation at school and/or faculty meetings and/or membership of several committees;
- Provide leadership in CIBEL's research projects, including in funding applications and other activities;
