This role will co-ordinate services and refer clients to direct support. This will assist in reducing the barriers that Aboriginal and Torres Strait people with unmet health needs experience when accessing mainstream services. This role will also run community-based health group activities for older Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

This is an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander identified position. Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people are encouraged to apply.
