The NCPC is seeking to recruit a Manager, full or part time (negotiable), salary range \$96,556 – \$100,419/annum pro rata. This is a 12 month contract with the possibility of extension.

While the successful applicant will be an employee of WACOSS, the NCPC will determine the focus, scope and direction of the work. WACOSS is the peak body of community service sector in Western Australia. WACOSS stands for an inclusive, just and equitable society. We advocate for social change to improve the wellbeing of West Australians and to strengthen the community sector service that supports them.

The Manager is responsible for ensuring the voice of Noongar people is heard and that the rights of all Aboriginal children and families on Noongar Land are protected. The Manager is responsible for developing, implementing and delivering the strategic and operational plans for the NCPC.

To be successful you will need demonstrated policy, research and analytical skills together with outstanding communication skills including the ability to produce high quality reports, submissions, and plans. You will also have a sound knowledge of child protection issues, experience in the community sector, the ability to work within a community development framework, and the capacity to work in a fast-paced and changing work environment.

We strongly encourage applications from Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people for the position.
