The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) is looking for qualified, experienced and motivated individuals to work within the Information Management & Technology Division (IMD) in various technical support roles across the division.

In this role you will provide critical operational 2nd and 3rd level support services and sustainment of ICT underpinning the Secure Australian Telecommunications and Information Network (SATIN) to over 95 overseas posts in five continents, Canberra and state and territory offices. This role gives the opportunity to work across and specialise in a broad range of ICT disciplines.

Information Management and Technology Division provide 24x7 ICT support to the global operations of the department. Some of these positions may require frequent domestic and international travel.

Candidates must be Australian citizens to be eligible for engagement. Employment in the department is dependent on gaining a valid security clearance. Loss of a security clearance at any time will lead to termination of employment. These are security-designated positions and the successful candidates will be required to have or be able to obtain a security clearance to Negative Vetting Level 2 prior to commencement.

Candidates' attention is drawn to the department's policy on recruitment or promotion to specialist positions. These positions are categorised as "specialists". Staff recruited to these positions will be required to remain in their area of specialisation for the duration of their employment with the department, unless they are successful in a subsequent merit-based selection process.

DFAT employees must demonstrate exemplary standards of integrity and professionalism at all times. Applicants in DFAT selection processes will be scrutinised in this regard.
