Eligibility: To be employed in a Defence Intelligence Agency, you will be required to undertake a Psychological Assessment and a Positive Vetting security clearance; you must be an Australian citizen and be able to account for your personal background for the last 0 years, or from 16 years of age, whichever is greater. As it may take 18 months for a Positive Vetting clearance to be granted, applicants seeking employment within the next 18 months are encouraged to apply.
