This currently includes cattle, sheep and carbon farming operations. AIA aspires to be a market leader in the sustainable and ethical production of food, fuel, fibre and carbon.

Under the direction of the National Manager C&E, lead the development and implementation of new initiatives, businesses and commercial opportunities in relation to the conservation and carbon economies to maximise benefits for Indigenous people. Develop effective collaborations with natural resource management bodies, government agencies, NGOs, Indigenous groups and other relevant stakeholders, including securing funding and co-investment to support business priorities, as appropriate.

Reporting directly to the National Manager, Carbon & Environment, the successful applicant will:

- Identify, investigate, develop and manage (as appropriate) commercial opportunities in the conservation economy to create benefits for Indigenous people. This may include developing funding proposals, business cases, investigating potential investments in environmental enterprises or analysing business ideas/commercial arrangements proposed to AIA
- Manage contracts, engage external service providers/consultants and otherwise engage key partners in line with procurement guidelines, relevant policies and other procedures
- Provide timely and quality advice and support to other sections of AIA regarding sustainable land management issues, including policy, planning, innovation and management in line with good industry practice

To be successful in this role you must have:

- a demonstrated ability to lead and facilitate the development, implementation and evaluation of environmental and/or sustainability projects and initiatives, particularly in the agricultural and/or environmental sector
- excellent oral and written communication skills, including the ability to draft high-quality written correspondence, proposals and reports, and to convey ideas clearly and concisely to a wide range of people both internal and external to AIA and the ILC
