- Ensure ASQA accreditation processes are in place to support Aboriginal workforce development and capacity.
- Develop comprehensive networks for dissemination of information regarding Aboriginal Family Health.
- Monitor and respond to developing trends or changes in areas such as clinical practice, community development, legislation, policies and practices of other government departments and the Aboriginal Community Controlled Sector to inform the training programs.

3. Knowledge of issues affecting victims of adult and child sexual assault, child abuse, family violence, racism and discrimination including knowledge and experience of working with Aboriginal people around issues of violence.
4. Ability to develop, implement and evaluate training programs and packages for Aboriginal and mainstream health workers.
5. Front line work experience with Aboriginal families and communities addressing family violence, sexual assault and/or child protection.
6. Competent with word processing programs and email.
7. Current driver's license valid within Australia and a willingness to travel within NSW.
