If you have experience and knowledge in the development and delivery of policy, programs and projects and use these skills in the context of land management and Traditional Owner policy development and/or implementation, you are strongly encouraged to apply. Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the issues affecting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples is also required.

This is a fixed term position for a period of 2 years.

To be considered for this position, your application should include a supporting statement demonstrating that you meet the key selection criteria and any job requirements specified in the position description.

The position requires an in-depth knowledge of Aboriginal culture and an ability to communicate with Aboriginal communities. Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people are encouraged to apply.
