



LECTURER IN INDIGENOUS HEALTH

The ANU College of Medicine, Biology and Environment (CMBE) brings together medical, biological, population health, psychological and environmental sciences in six schools: The ANU Medical School, The Fenner School of Environment and Society, The John Curtin School of Medical Research, the Research School of Biology, the Research School of Population Health, and the Research School of Psychology. Together the schools integrate high level research with a research-led curriculum that encompasses all of these different areas.

As the Associate Lecturer/Lecturer, you will provide academic input into the Indigenous health curriculum at the ANU Medical School and contribute to the Schools goal of closing the gap in health outcomes for Indigenous Australians. You will be required to further develop the Indigenous Health Program and will work closely with the Indigenous health staff and key School staff to achieve these goals and objectives.

The ANU strongly encourages applications from Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander persons. The filling of this position is intended to constitute a Special Measure to increase employment opportunities provided to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander persons in line with the strategies in the ANU Reconciliation Action Plan.
