The Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC) is a corporate Commonwealth entity established under the ATSI Act and subject to the PGPA Act. The ILSC assists Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to realise economic, social, cultural and environmental benefits that the ownership and management of land, water and water related rights can bring. The ILSC provides this assistance through the acquisition and management of rights and interests in land, salt water and fresh water country.

The Business Development Coordinator will lead the identification, development and implementation of projects that deliver economic, environmental, social or cultural benefits to Indigenous Australians. Specifically, the Business Development Coordinator will identify and lead the acquisition of property assets for divestment to Indigenous organisations and projects that support Indigenous landholders to maximise the productivity of their land.

In line with the ILSC's National Indigenous Land Strategy (NILS) and Our Land Our Future Program (OLOF), the Business Development Coordinator reports to the Divisional Manager and will be expected to:

- Proactively identify and develop proposals for the ILSC to assist Indigenous Organisations to manage land that they already own to deliver sustainable economic, environmental, social or cultural benefits
- As a member of the Divisional Management Team, contribute to, implement, monitor and report on the Divisional Corporate Priorities and Operational Plan to ensure that objectives are met in a timely and efficient manner
- Establish strategic relationships with key stakeholder and partner organisations including Indigenous corporations, Government agencies, NGO's and the private sector to partner or leverage investment to acquire and develop Indigenous land

The preferred applicant will be engaged on a 3 year Fixed Term Employment Offer under the provisions of the ILC Enterprise Agreement.
