Contemporary Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander art practice has long been central to MCA collection and exhibition programs. In addition, the MCA offers a number of important programs that focus on enhancing the engagement of visitors, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander audiences, with contemporary art and ideas. This exciting opportunity forms part of the MCA's commitment to assisting in building experience and capacity within a new generation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander visual arts professionals.

The position will be based at the MCA working within the Digital team of the museum and providing the successful applicant with valuable early career development opportunities. The successful applicant will work closely with the Head, Digital Media and the Digital Content Producer to create, edit and develop web experiences for various MCA digital projects. The successful applicant will have a demonstrated interest in and some experience with filming, editing, and photography, and familiarity with web content management systems and web publishing tools.
