Located on the South Street campus, Murdoch University Health comprises of two areas; the Counselling Service and the Medical Service. The Medical Service provides confidential and high-quality medical assessments, treatment and referrals for the wider Murdoch University community and promotes health and wellbeing activities on campus.

The multidisciplinary Medical Service Team consists of general practitioners, registered nurses and both administration and finance officers. In January of 2018, the Service successfully gained Accreditation against governing industry standards for general practices as set by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP).

The Role

The University Nurse will work within a highly dedicated team to provide a primary health care service to the broader Murdoch University community. The role will be required to perform clinical duties and to assist doctors with clinical procedures. The University Nurse will collaborate and liaise with other Murdoch University staff to provide health advice, promote services and provide support on OHS and First Aid issues that may arise. Success in this role requires an ongoing awareness of current and new legislation to ensure compliance with all statutory and regulatory obligations.

Skills and Experience

- Unrestricted registration in the category of Registered Nurse with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (AHPRA) and five years post qualification experience.
- Demonstrated ability to use diagnostic equipment such as an ECG or spirometer.
- Experience in emergency triage, phlebotomy and immunisation.
- Previous experience working in a non-hospital setting and/or general practice.
