The Medical and Molecular Sciences Cluster is responsible for the training of Biomedical Science, Laboratory Medicine, Molecular Biology and Forensic Science graduates. Advanced training in forensics is also offered via a Master of Forensic Science (Professional Practice), which is designed to provide advanced professional training in forensic investigation to the high level of skill needed to work with the police or other investigative authorities.

### The Role

A person with extensive experience in the professional practice, teaching and research of forensic science is required for a 0.5FTE fixed term contract (29 months) position. The new appointee in Forensic Science (Professional Scholar) will play several key roles:

- To run and maintain our successful and popular Master in Forensic Science (Professional Practice).
- To co-ordinate, design and deliver defined units within the Masters in Forensic Science course.
- To undertake high quality research in the field of forensics. Support and supervise students undertaking their Masters Projects; Honours and PhD projects.
- Develop a Unit in Forensic Chemistry and enhance the Masters course and the students experience by developing links with Government and Industry forensic providers.
- Teaching contributions will also be made to the undergraduate forensic degree courses in particular the undergraduate Forensic Biology and Tox major.
