HEALTH WORKFORCE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Do you want to increase your clinical skills?

If you are a rural or remote Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health professional and keen to expand your clinical skills or scope of practice, funding is now available to support your studies or training.

The Health Workforce Scholarship Program offers:

- up to \$10,000 to support studies in Certificate III and Certificate IV qualifications, to complete short courses and to attend conferences.
- up to \$10,000 per year, for two years, to support postgraduate qualifications such as a Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma or Masters.

Please note that you do not need an undergraduate qualification to be eligible for this funding. Many training organisations and universities will consider your application to study based on recognition of your career to date.
