The Palliative, Chronic and Complex Care Aboriginal Health Worker (AHW) role has been developed to enhance the delivery of respectful and culturally appropriate care to Aboriginal parents, carers and families who care for a child with a life limiting illness and/or chronic/complex medical condition.

This AHW role will work in partnership with the SCHN Palliative Care Services, General Medical Teams and other appropriate hospital based services to ensure Aboriginal children and families receive culturally responsive, holistic and well-coordinated care across the hospital and local Aboriginal communities.

The AHW will demonstrate leadership in improving Aboriginal Health outcomes for children with a life limiting illness and/or chronic complex medical conditions and their families in line with the SCHN Aboriginal Health Strategic Plan 2018-2021.
