Aboriginal Youth Justice Workers (Custodial)

Applications are now open for full-time youth justice workers at the Malmsbury and Parkville Youth Justice Precincts. You will be responsible for maintaining the safety and security of the facility and managing the challenging behaviours of the vulnerable young people in our custody.

You will need maturity, life experience and resilience to succeed as a youth justice worker.

- Access personal support from our Aboriginal Employment Team throughout your application and career with the department.
- Join a dedicated Aboriginal Staff Network – with over 100 members providing support, networking and development opportunities.
- No experience is required, six weeks paid training will be provided.
- Base salary of \$52,493, although entry-level staff earn on average up to \$76,650 after penalty rates and overtime.

We encourage you to attend a free information session with the General Manager of the facility, current youth justice custodial staff and the recruitment team to gain a better understanding of a career in youth justice:
