Multiple Aboriginal-identified roles based on beautiful Worimi Country, working alongside the Worimi Conservation Lands (WCL) in one of NSW's most significant joint-managed parks. The Worimi Conservation Lands are rich in Aboriginal cultural heritage. This Country holds deep spiritual and cultural significance for Worimi People.

As part of the National Parks and Wildlife Service, you'll be walking and working on Country—helping care for the land, yarning with community, and keeping culture strong. You'll be part of a solid, supportive team that values connection to Country, respects cultural knowledge, and works closely with Traditional Owners.

***Aboriginal Identified roles where Aboriginal identity, cultural knowledge or connections are a genuine aspect of the role. Positions are specifically noted under the provisions of the NSW Anti-discrimination Act (1977).***

#### **Park Manager (Ref 542797)**

The Park Manager is a new role and coordinates the delivery of the Worimi Conservation Lands Board of Management's (WCL Board) strategic and operational priorities, with a focus on cultural priorities. Working with the WCL Board and the Area's Leadership Team you will provide cultural leadership and ensure the conservation and protection of the cultural, natural and historic values of the Worimi Conservation Lands through developing and implementing strategic plans, programs and operations, consistent with statutory responsibilities and WCL Board priorities.

#### **Ranger (Ref 542786)**

The Ranger is responsible for effectively managing Aboriginal, natural and historic heritage by coordinating and supervising projects, environmental assessments, visitor engagement, and field-based activities, including bushfire management and law enforcement. The role contributes to achieving environmental and heritage obligations by ensuring the conservation of natural and cultural values within parks.

#### **Senior Field Officer (Ref 542054)**

The Senior Field Officer supervises the work of field officers and contractors to implement works and maintenance programs. Working closely with the Field Supervisor and Team Leader Field Operations, you'll join a supportive team undertaking a diverse range of tasks to enhance and preserve the natural and cultural heritage of our parks. This may include leading a team in the field to maintain and construct park facilities; protect cultural sites; undertake pest and weed control programs; and assist with fire management activities such as mowing, slashing, grading, hazard reduction burns and wildfire response.
