You will support, coach, and consult with school communities to plan for a whole school approach to mental health promotion, prevention and early intervention with the goal of improving mental health outcomes for young people, staff and their families.

You will provide considered, evidence-based support for schools to plan for, respond to and recover from a death by suicide, or a non-fatal attempt, impacting the school community.
