At a meeting convened by First Nations Legal and Research Services ('FNLRS') on 15 March 2025 in Kerang, those in attendance discussed the avenues for attaining rights over their Country and made a series of decisions in relation to next steps. The attendees decided, among other things, that:


- A) Barapa Barapa want to file a new native title claim to assert rights over Country; and
- B) Barapa Barapa requested that Arma Legal be their lawyers and to begin preparations to file the proposed new Native Title Claim.

#### **Purpose of Authorisation meeting**

Arma Legal will convene a meeting on Saturday 18 October 2025 in Barham, New South Wales for the purpose of discussing and deciding on matters relating to the proposed new Native Title Claim(s).

At this meeting, Arma Legal will explain the process for making a Native Title Claim. Then, an anthropologist will present his early research findings on the Proposed Claim Area of the Native Title Claim, a list of proposed apical ancestors for the Native Title Claim, and preliminary information about the connection and use of the Proposed Claim Area by Barapa Barapa People.
