## **The Organisation**

The First People of the Millewa-Mallee Aboriginal Corporation (FPMMAC) are a community of family groups who identify as Ngintait and Latji Latji that have maintained a continuous connection to their Traditional Country from the initial period of colonisation to present. They are the Traditional Owners and Custodians of Country in the northwest of Victoria and represent the rights and interests of all First Peoples of the Millewa-Mallee.

In their efforts to continue and expand their connection and cultural activities to their Traditional Country, FPMMAC deliver a range of programs focused on conservation, environmental restoration, natural resource management and ancestral reburial and protection in addition to cultural and heritage services. These programs and services are integral in creating economic opportunity, employment, expanding traditional languages and supporting the Aboriginal community.
